

What Does the Mask Ordinance Mean to Me?



The Newmarket Town Council adopted an Emergency Ordinance requiring the wearing of face coverings in the Town to combat the spread of COVID-19. We are not here to punish people. We are here to educate the importance of wearing one.

When do I have to wear one?

Basically, whenever it is not possible to keep a safe distance of six feet. This would include:

- Shopping at the grocery store or other retail establishment.
- Sitting in the stands close to others while watching a sporting event.
- Walking around your office/place of work when others are present.
- When standing in line at the store or other event.
- At restaurants, unless seated.

When don't I have to wear one?

This list is much longer. It includes:

- Exercising out or indoors and able to maintain a 6 foot distance.
- Walking on a sidewalk and you can maintain a 6' distance
- Playing a sport or sporting activity
- At home.
- In your car.
- When seated and adequately spaced from others at a food establishment
